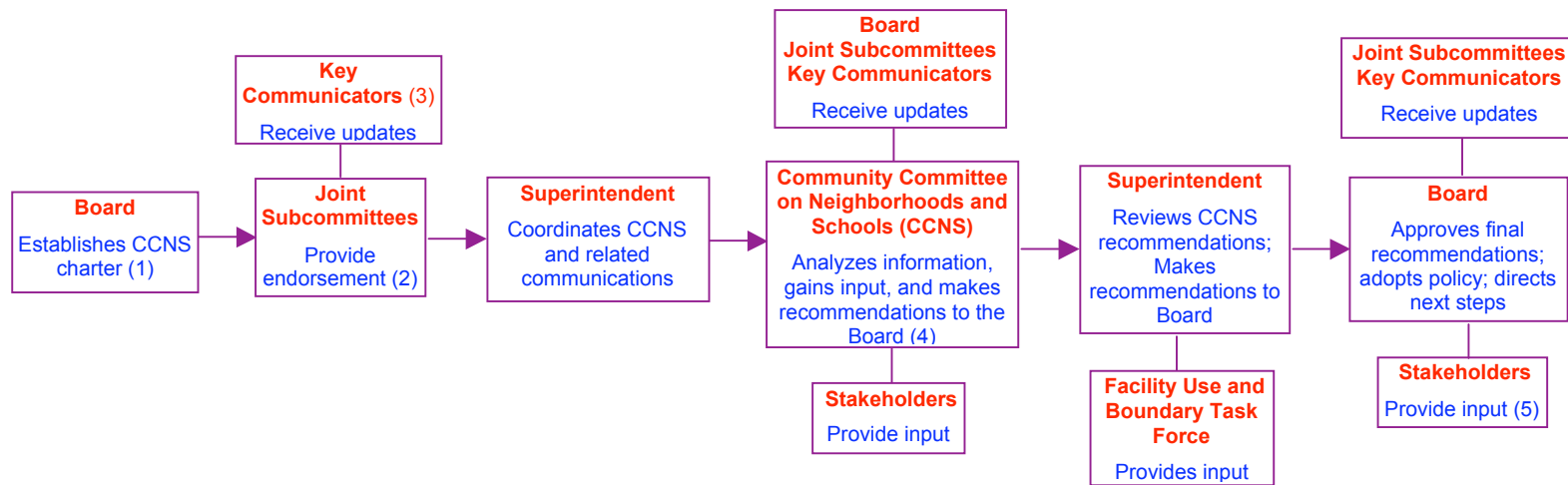

- (2) Agreement with CCNS charter and support to proceed.
- (3) In addition to media contacts, staff will maintain a database of “key communicators” to receive updates, announcements, and other important information. These key communicators will include the DAC, CACs, Principals, ACPTA, AARO, CAN, City of Austin, Neighborhood Associations, Education Austin, AAPSA, and others that will be identified.
- (4) The CCNS will recommend: criteria for identifying underutilized and overcrowded schools; criteria for assessing alternatives (revitalizing, repurposing, realigning, closing); opportunities for interlocal collaboration; and procedures for ensuring ongoing stakeholder engagement and participation. The CCNS recommendations will also address responding to state and federal accountability mandates. Throughout the committee’s deliberations, the community will be actively involved and the process will be transparent.
- (5) In addition to open meetings and citizen communications, the Board may wish to hold one or more public hearings or community forums to gain stakeholder input.
