


- Campus Comparable Improvement Reports published by TEA are also included in the Annual Report




2009-10 AEIS Report

 - Acknowledgements


Austin ISD Completion Rate I Class of 2009

- # Graduates + Continuers


Graduates + Continuers + GED + Dropouts

Additional AEIS Indicators include: College-Ready Graduates: ELA/Math/Both Subjects









Violent and Criminal Incidents Resulting in Disciplinary Action, 2009–2010
