## Preliminaries

- There were no public comments.

## Superintendent's Update

- COVID cases continue to decline only 80 total cases between staff and students
  - 0 4 vaccines clinics for pediatric does, 3 more this week in high-priority zip codes
  - 600 pediatric COVID vaccines have been distributed and at our Saturday clinic we will have a therapy dog
  - Central Office is offered Boosters shot
  - We will continue to stay the course and wear masks
- Have It All
  - One common application for all of our programs
    - Certifications in Cybersecurity, Fire Fighting, Nursing
    - Four Magnets, Three Single gender schools, Seven P-Tech
    - Seven Early College High School where students can earn an associate's degree by graduation
- ESSER Funds
  - ESSER I funds were supplanted by the state. The state said it was necessary to cover other funding.
  - ESSER II we only have \$30 million to use for the district
  - ESSER III \$155 million for supplanting, academic/school leadership, enrollment and technology

## **District Scorecard**

- New scorecard will be used for the district and it's aligned to our priorities and ensure it is equitable for all. Centered on our highest levers which are the following:
- Student achievement, Student well-being, Teacher and Employee well-being, culture of respect and customer service, Fiscal Stewardship and budget prioritization
- This new scorecard will have progress monitoring measures to ensure that we can adjust and monitor so that we meet our goals

## 87<sup>th</sup> Legislative Update

- AISD tracked 780 bills in the areas of Education, Public Information, Contract, Construction, Law Enforcement, Technology, Elections/Bonds
- # 1 priority HB 3 Fully Funded
- SB 15 allowed funding for students enrolled in local remote learning program i.e. virtual education
- HB 1525 allocated more funding for gifted & talented along with career & technology education
- HB 4545 was designed to accelerate learning for those student who did not pass STAAR or EOC at a 1:3 ratio
- HB 3979 stated that teachers shall explore topics objectively and in a manner free from political bias.

#### Long Range Planning (LRP)

- Equity by design training with seven different committees analyzing the needs of our community
- o Co-Chairs from the LRP will serve as voting members on the Bond Steering Committee
- This process truly focuses on ensuring that those who make the decision are receiving feedback from the people who are impacted by the decision.
