Superintendent's Update

- Enrollment district is at 74,000 and we are getting close to the goal of 77,000 students
 - Highlighted LBJ 153 more students this school year
- Success in our health protocols and our district is seeing a decline in positive cases on campus.
 - Week one 223 positive cases
 - Week three 159 cases positive cases
 - We will continue with our mask mandate as "it's the individual child that matters most"
- Vaccine clinics and staff incentives are keeping our student and all educators safe as possible
- Weekly campus visits
 - Making multiple campus visits throughout the district each week
 - Students are engaged in lessons and we continue to improve each and every day

TEA Waiver

- This waiver allows districts and charter schools to train staff on various educational strategies designed to improve student performance in lieu of student instruction during the school year. The Staff Development Minutes Waiver provides for a maximum of 2,100 total waiver minutes to use for professional development over the course of the 2021-2022 school year.
- Vote was held and the DAC voted in favor to support the waiver.

- Total number of student 3,112

 - Middle School 41
- Onboarding new staff members, increase family communication and engagement, supporting our ELs and Special Education students

- Building a positive school culture
 - Virtual assemblies will begin this week
 - Newsletters to build positive school culture
- Reviewing a hybrid model for transitioning and mirroring our student demographics

Covid-19 Review of district protocols

- Individuals can return after <u>7 symptom-free days</u> if they receive a negative test result (PCR or rapid antigen) on or after the 5th day.
- 6,000 air filtration units have been delivered to campuses for classrooms
- 400 Air scrubbers are thought AISD and located in large spaces
 - Consideration of those in Libraries
