PROCEEDINGS

Preliminaries

- The virtual meeting via Zoom was called to order by Dr. Jane Ross at 4:31pm.
- Vote of the DAC to approve minutes from September, October, November and January and motion passed to accept the minutes.

Read by Dr. Jane Ross from the Let's Talk app, Asking about Masks

Superintendent's Update

- COVID Update
 - O Seem to be past the Omicron Peak
 - o Cases dropped 56% from the week of January 31st
 - o 89% decrease from this time last month
 - 4 Covid vaccines clinics last week and added new testing sites Perez and Jordan Elementary
 - o Met with Dr. Wilks about COVID protocols/safety and will continue follow their guidance
 - O Working with Austin Public Health to open up Metz as a 7 day a week testing site.

Enrollment

- O Stabilizing enrollment post Covid drop and slowing rate of decline
- Our data show an average decline of 1.3% over a six-year period, 2013 (85,329)–2019 (80,912)
- o In 2019, we had an increase of almost 1,000 students—to nearly 80,000 students—but with COVID we dropped to around 74,500 students
- Our peer districts are also experiencing declines.
- This school year we did welcome 10,762 new students to AISD
- o 16,000 + students are attending charter schools; we are currently looking at transportation since parents have told us they are choosing charter because of this item.

- Long Range Planning leading to a Potential Bond
 - With our Strategic Plan and academic vision serving as the foundation, the Longrange Plan will chart a course toward a more equitable distribution of resources, opportunities and investments to support student achievement at every level.
 The Long-range plan will: Inform our annual budgeting process.
 - Identify which improvements and new facilities may be included in a future bond.
 - Benefit students and staff districtwide
 - The Long-range Planning Committees are charged with developing long-range plans, including a prioritized list of recommended initiatives, strategies, projects and programs for each of the planning categories: Academics and CTE, Athletics, Visual and Performing Arts, Facilities, Safety, Security, and Resiliency, Transportation, Food Services, and Maintenance and Technology.
 - o The committee is currently in stage 3 and 4 of the Equity by design process.

Career & Technical Education Overview

- Reviewed the vision and mission of the program
- CTE is for all students and is no longer focused on vocational education but centered on postsecondary partnerships and that process starts in middle school
- 25,000 students enrolled in one CTE course, 320 CTE teachers, articulated agreements with ACC
- Elementary schools will now participate in career awareness activities
- Members commented about the demographic breakdown of programs by schools.

TAPR Report

- State mandated performance report prepared by TEA
- Collection of multiple data points to determine a district/schools accountability rating
- STAAR/ECO Performance grades 3 -12 determine is students are ready for the next grade level
- Demographic Data: 51% EcoDis, Emergent Bilingual 28%, Disciplinary Placement 1%, At-Risk 47.2%, SpEd 13%, and GT 12%, Bilingual 31%
- Members requested a follow up meeting to delve into the content and have a better understanding of it.
