Fake & Fatal – Fentanyl Awareness

- Public health crisis and #1 cause of accidental deaths

- 14 -23 years old and most likely to die from overdoses
- Narcan will be on all AISD campuses from a generous donor
 - Does not need an RX

- Educate staff, students and community
 - Campus training will occur with RNs, administrators and others who are interested

Equity Update

- Review of Equity by Design 8 step strategy. Utilized with EAC, Bond and Long Range Planning and the Equity Assessment.
- AIR is the firm that will be conducting the audit, this group will co-interpret the data with AISD staff members and the community to create action steps
 - Report will be completed in the Summer of 2023
 - This vendor was selected because they will be going out into the community to seek feedback in non-traditional ways.
 - Focus groups will be created

Budget Updates

- Recapture 846 Million from our current budget, 87% of our budget is dedicated to teacher and staff salaries
- ESSER 2 funds will be exhausted by this school year
- Members requested a more in-depth overview of the budget to show full transparency
- Members worked in teams to set budget priorities for the 2023-2024
 - 1. Teacher/Staff Compensation
 - 2. Special Education
 - 3. Mental Health
 - 4. Multilingual
