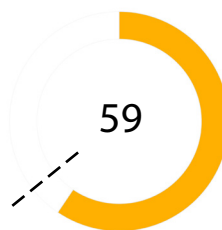

Facility Summary

Odom Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 335 students in south Austin, is known as a neighborhood school built in 1970 with additions that followed. A multipurpose space was added in this past year. The campus has several different types of studio settings. There is one wing that has pod configurations. Each pod has six studios and shares multipurpose rooms, restrooms and storage. Another wing has an open-concept configuration where studios do not have full walls. The last studio area is more typical with individual studios.

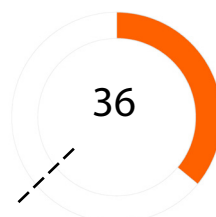

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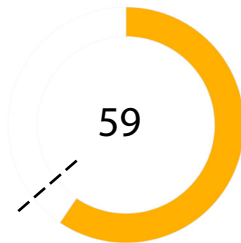

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.

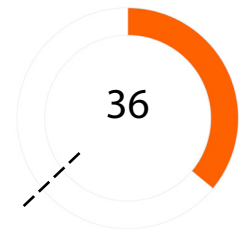
